




From the Minister - Rev Dr Allan Vint

Over this last session, thankfully we managed to get back to some weekday evening, in-person discussions about Christian topics. Our chosen theme this time around came via a video presentation of John Ortberg, a Presbyterian pastor in the USA, about our Soul and the benefits of keeping it healthy.



John reminded us about the great value of our soul and of its need to be cared for. He used the helpful illustration of a mountain stream, tended by a keeper who looks after its welfare – making sure it is regularly cleared of junk and debris so that it flows to the benefit of those downstream. John highlights the fact that without the keeper the stream can become polluted or stagnant which causes all sorts of problems. He says, 'the soul is the stream, and you are the keeper'.

We were challenged in our discussions about how well we are tending to that most central and important part of our being – after all it is our soul which connects us with God and which, united to

Jesus, brings us eternal life. Yes, the question for us all is surely, are we tending our soul well and wisely?

"Have nothing to do with godless myths and old wives' tales; rather, train yourself to be godly. For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come."
