



#### From the Minister – Rev Dr Allan Vint



It was an honour on the 13<sup>th</sup> of November to lead the annual service of Remembrance in Mauchline Church and at the War Memorial. This is such an important occasion as we take time to give thanks for all who make the ultimate sacrifice for our freedoms. This year we took as our theme 'Heroes', recalling Archie Perry who had been assistant scoutmaster at the 1<sup>st</sup> Mauchline Scouts. We heard how, aged 13, he had rescued another boy from the river Avon, near where he lived at the time. This man then aged 17 headed off to Kilmarnock to join the war effort – his service took him to France but sadly there his life ended. His name is not recorded on our local war memorial and I suspect his heroism both home and abroad was largely unknown. Let us never forget the cost borne by those known and unknown to us who ensured our liberties.



In entering into December our mind naturally turn to Christmas and all that it will contain. At Mauchline church we will be moving through the Advent period by giving special consideration to the themes that lie at the Heart of Christmas – Hope, Peace, Joy and Love. In reaching the 25<sup>th</sup> of December we will have a special Christmas service celebreting the gift of God in Jesus.

Entitled 'Miner's Son to Manse' it set out his growing up within a small West Lothian mining village before heading off to



Aberdeen University to study Computer Science. The life story, full of twists and turns, shared how God would eventually call Allan to leave his chosen career path to apply for the ministry. The process would lead to Allan to put on his clerical collar just as the infamous 'Piper Alpha Disaster' affected the lives of so many – including his own, as he became involved in the care of the bereaved and injured in his Aberdeen parish area. The fellowship will hear part two of the minister's biography in 2023, perhaps called 'From Motherwell to Mauchline!'.
